Approval Process: Funding requests over \$500 need to be reviewed and approved by the Foundation Board of Directors during a regular scheduled board meeting. Our regular scheduled board meetings are held the last Wednesday of the month on odd months. If your requests is over \$500 please submit in a timely manner to allow for this approval process. We will not hold a special meeting or approval process to accommodate your request.

Funding requests of \$500 and under will need to be reviewed by the Foundation Chairperson and Director. These funding requests will be reviewed and approved/denied within 3 weeks of submission.

Funding Initiatives
