Financial Assistance

CHI LakeWood Health provides financial assistance to eligible patients in need. The policy is based upon household size and 300% of the federal poverty base. If a household income is under the income base the entire amount of health care services provided are eligible for charity care. Eligible individuals need to complete a financial assistance application. 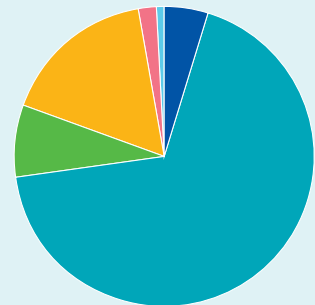

Community Benefit

Non-profit Hospitals are required to annually report community benefit. Community benefits are measured in monetary value. CHI LakeWood Health provided \$1,588,236 of community benefit for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020. The primary components of community benefit are:
