CHI LakeWood Health provides significant financial assistance and community benefit to Lake of the Woods County.



Financial Assistance

CHI LakeWood Health provides financial assistance to eligible patients in need. The policy is based upon household size and income percent of the federal poverty level (FPL). Any patient whose Family Income is at or below 200% of the FPL is eligible to receive Financial Assistance up to a 100% discount from his or her account balance for eligible services provided to the patient after payment, if any, by any third-party(ies). Any patient whose Family Income is at or above 201% but lower than 400% of the FPL is eligible to receive Financial Assistance reducing his or her account balance for eligible services provided to the patient after payment, if any, by any third-party(ies), to an amount no more than the Hospital Facility's AGB. Eligible individuals need to complete a financial assistance application. 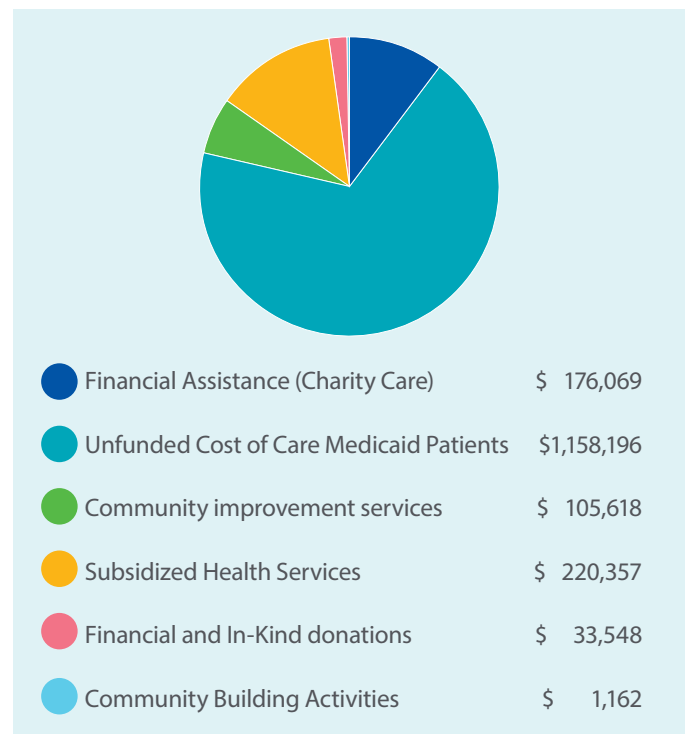
